THE GATTEGNO PEDAGOGY

CALEB GATTEGNO

Created by Caleb Gattegno in the 50's, this educational approach is based on the recognition of learning abilities that each individual possesses.

This pedagogy fosters creativity, participation and human production. By putting in concrete learning situations the learner rediscovers what he knows and defines his own needs. It reactivates, for this work, ability to learn and become aware of their possibilities.

Each person can then make the necessary connections to any acquisition to integrate sustainable and usable knowledge at any time.

AN ANSWER TO A SOCIAL NEED

In the social context of recent years, with increasing insecurity for public low-skilled, the business of teaching basic skills meets a latent needs of our society and is in control plans against exclusion and against unemployment.

Obviously this is not because the teacher teaches a student learns.

For Gattegno, learning, whether walking, mother tongue or skiing, is taken by successive awarenesses. Learning is always a succession of awareness.

This notion is very important, because it is clearly not possible for a person to become aware for another. Learning is never a knowledge transfer from one individual to another.

It is always the learner who is responsible for their learning.

In these circumstances, the role of the trainer:

- is to subordinate his teaching to learning,
- is to create situations that will allow insights from the learner, based on the powers of the learner which is an autonomous individual,

This is to enable the learner to rely also on his powers, his perceptions, his senses, his sense of truth, consistently for him. This so he can build endpoints that give it an outlet on the unknown that is the reading, spelling ... so he can determine what exercise required of him.

 is to allow each learner to do what he knows he should do, to be aware of potential problems that can slow learning and to bring the learner to become aware of and overcome difficulties



TABLE OF SOUNDS / COLOUR



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"Each colour represents a phoneme of French and there are as many colours as phonemes. The order is the same as that of Fidel. Some rectangles are composed of two colours for complex sounds. The table is divided into two parts, the vowels in the upper part and the consonants and the semivowels in the lower part."

FIDEL FOR SPELLING



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"These tables provide all the sounds of French organized so that all the spellings of each sound are stored by column. We discover that there are only 4 ways to write the sound [e] but 38 [b], the letter "e" appears in virtually every colour, that same letter or the same set letters can be said, therefore, coloured in various ways. This material allows to embrace the entire system of the French language in a single glance and engage in rigorous work on spelling. "

PANELS WORDS OF SILENT WAY FRENCH


"One of the 11 tables where the functional vocabulary words lies the French. All signs (graphemes) representing the same sound are the same colour. Words written on the same line are not necessarily related by meaning. However, any words or table of all tables can be joined to form affecting in sentences with a pointer in a temporal order. THE CUISENAIRE RODS

"These small pieces of wood or plastic created by Georges Cuisenaire, are between 1 and 10 centimetres in length and have a section of a square centimetre. They are coloured in such a way that all the strips of the same length have the same colour, the colour choice reflects the mathematical properties of the rods.



They are used to teach mathematics at all levels. In the course of Silent Way languages, are used to create non-ambiguous situations that allow students to understand how to express different concepts in the target language. In connection with these situations, students are able to check their assumptions about the functioning of the language while still knowing the exact meaning of their sentence. OBJECTIVES SOUGHT IN "INFUSED READING"


This CD is likely to enable non-readers to start their learning to read, and bring them to a point where they understand all the mechanisms needed to read. In particular, they know

- a) the French language is read from left to right;
- b) it is what it says on the page that dictates what to say the discipline of reading has it that the writer who decides what we read and not our pleasure ...;

- c) the sounds of the language are represented by letters or groups of letters. They can be quite varied but there is still a degree of consistency;
- d) the number of combinations is great but can be mastered;
- e) allow the letters to find the sounds.


